The United States Surfing Federation Western Region is a non-profit corporation, incorporated in California.

The USSFWR is the sanctioned representative of the United States Surfing Federation on the West Coast. The United States Surfing Federation is the only organization representing amateur surfing in the United States of America recognized by the International Surfing Association.

USSFWR Championship Tour, District Series and Women's specialty event surf contests include competition by division for contemporary shortboards, longboards, bodyboards and kneeboards male and female of all ages. (Some divisions may be combined at certain contests when less than 6 or 8 surfers enter a contest in their division unless it is deemed that this will upset competitive balance in that event.

The WRSA 2003-2004 contest season begins in July '03 and ends in June '04. It includes an 11-event Championship Tour -- a District Series of 4 \*\*\*\* rated events in Nor Cal, L.A., Orange County and San Diego and a Women's Tour of 4\*\*\*\* specialty events. The "Tour" concludes with the Hoppy Swarts Memorial West Coast Championships Event.
